

Clicker Joy offers a class for Basic Manners and Foundation Skills on Tuesday evening

Our Basic Manners and Foundation Skills class teaches the puppy/dog foundation behaviors needed for manners, social skills, and all other working, or competition dog skills. The class is structured around a modular format.

Under this approach your dog learns several behaviors that support specific objectives in each session, like "Going out in public", "Attention to You, and "Self-Control", for example. This class format works very well for both puppies and adult dogs.

The emphasis of clicker trainers is progressive, positive reinforcement that teaches the animals to learn and helps us learn from the animals, which is a blast! Clicker training is behavior based using operant conditioning.

An initial "Orientation to Clicker Training" is offered as an introduction to the Basic Manners class. This first orientation to clicker class is without your dog so you can begin to develop your skills as a clicker trainer before teaching new behaviors to your puppy/dog. It's important to attend an orientation before beginning class.
